Our Workshops - We offer a changing programme of engaging and fun seasonal creative and reminiscence activities every month for your residents. Our workshop facilitators are trained and experienced in working in care settings with people who have complex needs and dementia. Through booking regular workshops you also benefit from reductions and promotions on our training and resources. We provide workshop records for each of the sessions we deliver to support your care planning and activity evidence.
